President and Chief Executive Officer of Siemens AG

Klaus Kleinfeld (49) is President and Chief Executive Officer of Siemens AG. Since joining Siemens in 1987, he has had key strategic and leadership roles. He was the founder and CEO of Siemens Management Consulting, a unit helping to drive operational and strategic changes at many Siemens businesses. Mr. Kleinfeld then led the Angiography, Fluoroscopic- and Radiographic Systems, an important part of Siemens' Medical business and became a member of the group board. Later, as President and CEO of Siemens USA, he led an unprecedented profit turnaround in the company's largest market. Shortly after he joined the Siemens AG Managing Board in 2004, he was named deputy CEO and then beginning of 2005 CEO and President.

He serves on the Boards of Alcoa, Inc., Bayer AG, Citigroup Inc., the New York Metropolitan Opera and the International Business Council of the World Economic Forum.

He holds a Master's degree in Business Administration / Economics from the University of Göttingen, Germany, and a Ph.D. in Strategic Management from the University of Würzburg, Germany.
